### Learning & Teaching

Many wonderful learning opportunities are evident in all classrooms. Supported by the Ochre resources, our students (and teachers) are settling into the routines of daily reviews and the explicit teaching sequence, particularly in English and Mathematics. Coupled with hands-on materials, our students are provided with an evidence-informed approach that caters to the needs of all students.

Students in Years 3 and 5 have begun their preparation for Naplan testing. This involves developing and increasing their 'test-wiseness' by practising Naplan 'type' questions, sharing strategies and receiving explicit teaching of skills and concepts from their teachers.


While our staff have been on the MACS Vision For Instruction journey for a year now, we invite parents and carers to a 'Learning Matters' parent session informing you about what a mathematics classroom looks like in 2025 in light of the Vision For Instruction. This session will outline the what, why and how behind daily reviews, explicit teaching and formative assessment. The first session will take place on Wednesday 26th March at 9.15 am. The session will be repeated on Tuesday 1st April at 2.45 pm. A communication will be sent out in the coming weeks.

We are excited about the changes we are implementing in learning and teaching at St Dominic's and look forward to more engaging learning opportunities for our students and families.

### DigiTech News: eSafety

#### App checklist for parents



#### Checklist

The aim of this checklist is to help you navigate the app world and give you the tools to ensure you and your family enjoy safe and positive online experiences.

#### Do your research

- · The eSafety Guide is a good starting point.
- Other sources include <u>Common Sense Media</u> and <u>ConnectSafely</u>, which review the most popular apps.
- · Search for recent reviews from Google Play and Apple Store.
- Discuss the benefits and risks with family or friends who use the app.

eSafety tip: Check whether the app can be used for content sharing, photo and video sharing, messaging and online chat, voice chat, video calling, live streaming, gaming, in-app purchasing, online relationships, location sharing and encryption.

#### Check the age rating and requirements

- Apps usually state a minimum age for users in their terms of use but they don't all have verification requirements.
- The eSafety Guide includes the stated age for many popular apps.
- · Common Sense Media makes an independent assessment of provides age recommendations.
- Check the advice on the eSafety Parent page Are they old enough?

eSafety tip: When deciding if an app is suitable for your child, think about their level of maturity and judgement as well as the age recommendation.

- Consider privacy read the terms and conditions and ask yourself these questions:
- · What information does the app request?
- · Does the app provide privacy protections?
- · Can you restrict who sees your profile?
- · Who can find you in a search?
- · What information can people see about you?

eSafety tip: See the eSafety page <u>Connecting safely – Apps</u> for more advice. <u>The eSafety Guide</u> contains links to information about how to adjust privacy settings in popular apps.

- Check the permissions and other settings read the community guidelines and ask yourself these questions:
- · What permissions does the app request?
- · What information the app collect?
- Does the app need microphone and/or video camera access to perform its functions?
- What are the default settings?
- · Do you need to change default settings, initially and after each update?
- · Does the app allow in-app purchases?

eSafety tip: See the eSafety Parents page <u>Taming the technology</u> for advice on using parental control and safe browsing tools.

#### Safety check

- Can you report things in the app? (For example: online abuse, impersonator accounts, offensive
  or illegal content)
- · Is the in-app reporting process easy and clear?
- · Are the in-app reporting options limited or can you report a wide range of safety concerns?

eSafety tip: Let you child know they can come to you for help if anything makes them feel uncomfortable or unsafe and they won't be in trouble. You can help them report serious online abuse to the eSafety Commissioner.

#### Parent Communication

There are a number of online platforms & apps that we use to communicate to our community.....



**Audiri** is a free app which supports more immediate, school/ level-wide communication.

\*\*We use this app for communicating from the school to families for instant messages, school calendar.

**Operoo** is an electronic form system that automatically collates medical and emergency details.

This makes this important information instantly available to authorised staff.

\*\*We also use Operoo to send e-forms, excursion forms, permission forms, etc. Operoo allows only one primary owner, who then shares access.

#### SeeSaw

SeeSaw is a communication app, which is managed by each teacher. They will communicate with you about your child's learning or specific messages for your class.



#### **WhatsApp**

Class Parent Representatives set up a class only group to communicate information to parents directly relating to the class. SEE BELOW

### Ongoing Reminders....

#### Morning Drop off times & Supervision:

Staff playground supervision commences at 8.30am each school morning and classroom doors open at 8.45am. NOTE: there is not a Staff member on duty in P1- Junior Playground, therefore NO children should be playing in this area before school.

Until 8.30am each day, we request that no children are dropped off at school, where possible. If work commitments require earlier drop offs, we recommend you contact our OHSC provider, Beyond Educare, as this may be an option for your family. If you need to discuss this, please call our office.

#### Safety:

We ask that students not come into school in the morning carrying hot drinks up the driveway and across the yard. This presents a safety issue in the event of hot liquid spilling onto themselves or another child. Please DO NOT allow your children to come into school with a hot drink in their hands for this safety reason. While at school, all students are expected to be seated when eating or drinking, and this includes any drinks they come into school with. Thank you for your understanding.

#### **Afternoon Pickup times & Supervision:**

Staff supervision after school is from 3.30-3.45pm. This is at the front of the school and all students waiting to be picked up must remain there, supervised by a Staff member until picked up by a family member. Students cannot linger in the playground area after school as this area is not supervised. Any student still at school by 3.45pm will then wait in the office area and a parent will be contacted. We do remind parents that should you be running late, please contact the office to advise and avoid unnecessary worry for your child. If work commitments require later pickups, we recommend contacting OHSC Beyond Educare, as this may be an option for your family.

#### Communication:

Clear communication is vital and our key channels of communication are Operoo, Audirri, Newsletter, Bulletin & SeeSaw. Please regularly check on all forms of communication, particularly when receiving notifications for Operoo or Audirri information, and each Thursday for our Newsletter or Bulletin.

### BOROONDARA Photography Tips from our Judges - the Curators at the Town Hall Gallery



- File size an image under 1MB may look good on a phone screen but it will look terrible when printed. Always make sure your photograph is 300 dpi or 300 ppi and at least over 600 kb and preferably at least 1MB in size.
- Focus even slightly blurry images are more noticeable when printed. Unless you want an intentional blur in your photos, zoom in to check that your final photo is in focus.
- Experiment you get points for creativity, so experiment with elements like composition and light. Take a photo of your subject from different angles and different times of day the decide which photo looks the best.
- Photograph description: when entering you are asked to describe your photograph and where it was taken in Boroondara. This is the 'artistic statement' for your photograph. The judges are interested in your description as it complements the photograph.
- Check the Background Before taking your photo, look for anything in the background that could be distracting. You want to control what the viewer focuses their attention on. If choosing between two similar photos, sometimes checking the background for anything distracting will help make your choice.
- Think Theme before you take or select your final photo, think about what 'Hidden Boroondara' means to you and how your photo reflects that meaning. Thinking about how a photo reflects your point of view will help you select a photo that will feel original and intriguing to judges.

- Photographs can be edited, for example, cropped or other minor enhancements
- Photographs that have been digitally altered or generated with Artificial Intelligence will be ineligible.


